Advocacy Center partners are involved in the most difficult cases in Brevard County, including cases of child sexual or severe physical abuse, and neglect. CACB is a multi-agency collaboration of the Child Protection Team, the Florida Department of Children and Families, both of which are onsite at the Advocacy Center; Brevard County Sheriff's Office and municipal law enforcement agencies, the Office of the State Attorney and community mental health professionals. The CACB Clinical Intervention Program provides immediate mental health crisis counseling for child victims and their non-offending family members. Major onsite services provided by the Child Protection Team include medical exams, medical consultations, and specialized and forensic interviews.
