Dr. Williamson received his Bachelors in Psychology in 1984 from the University of Kansas. He then went on to earn his Master's and Doctorate in Clinical Psychology (with a specialty in Child Psychology) from the University of Missouri-Columbia. He is a member of the American Psychological Association and a member of the Society for Research in Child Development.

In September of 1991 he became the Program Director of Circles of Care's Adolescent and Family Counseling until he began his private practice in 1994. He has served as an adjunct faculty member at the University of Central Florida, Rollins College, Florida Tech and Webster University. He currently serves as a psychological consultant with the Child Protection Team and provides evaluation and consultation to the 18th Judicial Circuit Court in dependency juvenile and family law cases.

Dr. Williamson has published in the Journal of Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrics (1988), the American Journal of Psychotherapy (1989), the Journal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology (1991), and the Family Psychologist (1992). He has given over 140 professional presentations on childhood psychopathology, family therapy and parenting.
